## Worldwide Challenge on Informatics and Computational Thinking

Bebras is an international initiative aiming to promote informatics (computer science, or computing) and computational thinking among school students of all ages. The challenge is organized annually by each participating country locally. Participants are usually supervised by teachers who may integrate the Bebras tasks into their teaching activities.

The Bebras challenge dates back to 25th September 2004, when an experimental trial was held in Lithuania. In the following years, in more and more countries, the Bebras idea found followers who annually met to develop tasks. Now, the Bebras Challenge has spread to more than 70 countries.
